The I am greater campaign, launched in May 2021, was developed with young people from across Greater Manchester and the Greater Manchester Violence Reduction Unit to encourage young people to take positive actions and promote wellbeing, all to reduce the likelihood of young people experiencing violence.

Phase 4 of the I am greater campaign is targeting 14-25 year-olds who are are most at risk of being involved in violence across the 10 boroughs of Greater Manchester.

About the campaign







This campaign is Phase 4 of the I am greater campaign with the Greater Manchester Violence Reduction Unit. Our target audience is 14-25 years old across the 10 boroughs of Greater Manchester who may be at risk of being involved in violence.

This phase of the campaign focuses on highlighting the opportunities in Greater Manchester that are available for young people to go to such as youth hubs and sports or arts classes.

To do this, we are using the **Easter school holidays** to promote some of the **positive activities taking place across Greater Manchester that young people can get involved in** whilst out of school.

This is where you can get involved: use the I am greater campaign and our key messages to promote the activities, sessions and workshops in your areas that young people can join.

The physical installation

Additionally, there will be a temporary physical installation in Gorse Hill Studios to serve as a statement and engagement piece for the young people to interact with.

We will have an artist create an artistic mural of a map of Greater Manchester representing our diverse region and the positive organisations that support young people to be greater.

The focal part of the piece will be the **letters of the campaign** name "I am greater".

These will be blank and serve as a canvas for the young people to share their voice, writing their thoughts, feelings and ambitions on - such as what they would like to see in their local community, their thoughts on how they can 'be greater than violence'.






